

FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions) about construction projects

Monies being spent for the restoration of the destroyed high school do not come from local taxpayers. All of our facilities are insured and insurance is paying for the restoration.

Monies being spent to repair and renovate other district facilities are from voter approved bond funds. These funds must be spent for the purposes for which the voters approved, and cannot be spent on operational costs (i.e.: Supplies, Utilities, Salaries & Benefits, Purchased Services, etc.).

District monies are budgeted into different funds such as “Management & Operation Fund”, “Capital Funds”, “Federal Grant Funds”, “State Grant Funds”, etc. State laws and regulations dictate how many dollars are put into these funds. School Districts are not allowed to move monies from one fund to another, and they can only spend the money for the specific purposes of the particular fund into which they allocated.

The Governing Board of our school district is elected, on a non-partisan basis, to represent you the taxpayers, students, parents, and constituents. One of the major responsibilities of the Board is to provide financial oversight.

The District has an annual audit of its finances and financial procedures to assure we are compliant with all federal and state laws and regulations.
