Dear Parents, Staff & Students,

As we get ready to head out for Spring Break next week, we want to remind our Round Valley community to be aware of steps to take to remain healthy:

- Frequent hand washing (for at least 20 seconds)
- Cover coughs and sneezes
- Reduce physical contact

We will be using the time during spring break for extra cleaning of hard surfaces, buses, food prep areas – any surface that we come in contact with on a day-to-day basis.

The proper steps to take if you think you or someone you know have symptoms of the COVID-19 virus is to contact:

1. Primary care provider (call for an appointment)
2. County Health Department
3. Emergency Room (please call before going so proper measures can be taken when you arrive)
4. Have a contingency plan in place should you or a family member become ill.

If a student or staff member is diagnosed with a confirmed case of COVID-19, the district will take swift action based on advice from state and county health offices to protect students, employees and citizens in the community. The schools would be closed for 48 hours for thorough cleaning.

IF the schools close due to the Coronavirus, we will set up a “Hot Line” and email account to help maintain health, counseling, social services, etc. for those in need.
